## THE PROBLEM

### We've produced strong guidance

Physical Security Guide, 3 risk assessments, emergency plan, self-assessment, Martyn's Law webinar — all ready to distribute.

### But mosques can't act alone

Most lack the expertise and contacts to find trustworthy security vendors. They don't know who to call, what a fair price looks like, or how to avoid being overcharged.

### Martyn's Law makes this urgent

SIA enforcement begins April 2027. Every place of worship must comply — regardless of size. As the deadline nears, predatory vendors will cold-call mosques with fear-based pitches and inflated prices.

Our guidance tells mosques *what* to do. Nothing yet tells them *who can help*.

- Cybersecurity
- Insurance
- Training
- Emergency Planning
- Fire Safety

### How it connects to our existing work:

**Security Framework** — self-assessments and risk assessments surface gaps; the directory provides qualified vendors to fill them

**Martyn's Law** — webinar builds awareness; directory provides the compliance consultants and contractors mosques need to act

**PSMS Lobbying** — vendor cost data quantifies the funding gap; vendors become allies providing expert testimony
